Module Two - Resilience - Emotional Intelligence

Transform disempowering feelings into effective action. Identify and de-escalate conflicts to a peaceful conclusion. Have classroom management be less stressful and feel more energized at the end of the day.

Module Three - Compassion - Your 5 Personalities - Connecting to Your Humanity

Understand students' challenging behavior and how to address it. Connect and communicate to get the results you want. Know what motivates people to do what they do so there can be a peaceful resolution.

Module Four - Leadership - Civility - Live Love Lead Open Hearted and In-Charge

Develop a powerful sense of belonging, teamwork, and sense of responsibility. Schools can be safer as everyone treats themselves and others with dignity, civility, and respect. Improve attendance and decrease, bullying, detentions, suspensions, expulsions and suicide.
